Memorial Day Parade 2004

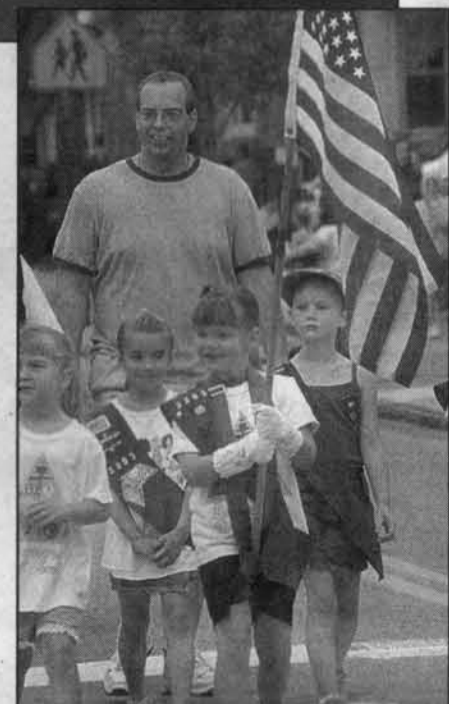

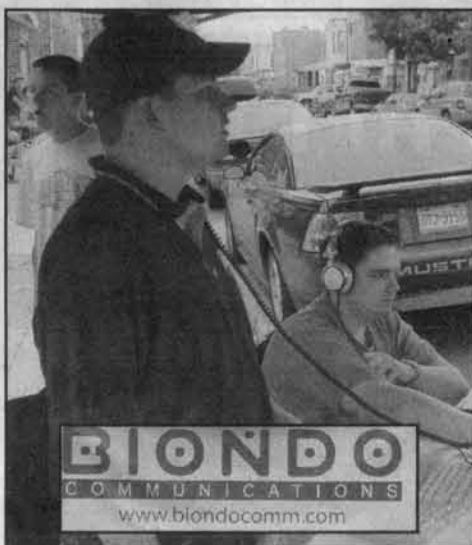
